MFSM Application Eligibility Criteria

1. TACC exists for the sole purpose of helping children up to and including the age of 18.
2. Consideration for MFSM opportunities will be given to children up to the age of 18 years who are disadvantaged by disability, poverty, education, violence and/or lifestyle.
3. TACC reserves the right to consider all applications individually and on their own merit.
4. Favourable consideration will be given to those applications which directly benefit a number/large number of children and/or positively increase the quality of their lives.
5. Applications can be submitted at any time. TACC trustees discuss applications at regular intervals and will reply to successful and unsuccessful applications shortly within 4 weeks of receipt of application.

MFSM Application Information and Process

- **Each successful applicant will receive a match ticket and in addition each child will receive**
 - **A new Scotland football shirt**
 - **A small Scotland saltire flag**
 - **£12.50 pocket money**
- **If successful, you will be sent a second form to provide details of the child/children attending including name, age and shirt size. Also the contact details of the supervisors attending the match with the child/children plus the contact details of the person responsible for distributing the packages to each child. Only when the sizes are obtained will the shirts be ordered.**
- **Note "My First Scotland Match" operates for both men's and women's matches (usually at Hampden Park Glasgow). If you are offered a women's match and you decline it, your group will go to the back of the queue.**
