## Aberlour Child Care Trust

TACC is delighted to announce its partnership with **Aberlour Child Care Trust**.

Aberlour is the largest solely Scottish child care charity, working with children, young people and families who need additional support, to promote their development and well being. Its activities include:

**Children and families affected by disability**

**Children and families affected by drug and alcohol abuse**

**Children and young people affected by physical and sexual abuse**

TACC will kick off this new relationship by inviting 32 children from around Scotland and supported by Aberlour to the Scotland vs Northern Ireland and Scotland vs Norway matches at Hampden Park as part of My First Scotland Match.

We will also be launching a Christmas present campaign, encouraging fellow Scotland supporters to help bring a little happiness to children supported by Aberlour this Christmas.

Aberlour's Chief Executive Addie Stevenson comments "We are so proud to be supported by TACC, our children and young people are very excited about seeing their first Scotland match. As Scotland's largest children's charity, our ethos goes hand in hand with Supporting Scotland, supporting children."

## Away

In the past two years TACC has donated **£27,000** to children in Ukraine and Georgia.

### Ukraine – TartanKiev campaign, 2006

We donated **£5,500** each to:

#### School of Arts for Children with Impaired vision.

Essentially a school for blind or 95% blind orphaned or abandoned children.

#### Kiev City Orphanage # 5

A temporary refuge for children brought off the streets and “de-traumatised” before being placed in a permanent orphanage.



### Georgia – TartanTbilisi campaign, 2007

We donated **£10,000** and **£5,000** respectively to:

#### Tbilisi Infant Hospital

Our £10,000 donation paid for a new incubator and other life-saving equipment for premature orphaned babies.

The hospital sent us these photos. The great news is the baby in the photo had been in the incubator and is now recovering – the first life saved by the generosity of Scotland supporters.



#### Martkopi Orphanage

A home for orphaned or abandoned disabled children.



### Macedonia – TartanSkopje, 2008




TACC's next away match donation will be in Skopje, Macedonia in September 2008.

Following discussions with the British Embassy there, we have decided to help these two worthy causes.

#### Snezana

A day care centre for street children. They have asked for basics such as shoes, towels, toiletries, clothes and school equipment.



#### Topaansko Pole

A centre/home for severely disabled children (120 children in all, 60 of whom live there). They have asked for help with renovations to toilets, showers, and/or new beds and mattresses.



**Our goal is to raise £12,000 for these children.**

## We have a dream

We'll shortly be launching our “**We have a dream**” World Cup 2010 campaign in partnership with Oxfam, where supporters of the charity will be able to help us sponsor 2 children's projects in South Africa. TACC's initial target will be £100,000.


